<u>HOSTS</u>

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Dear guests, welcome and thank you for choosing to spend your holidays in our house, hoping that you can feel at home.

We think it is important for you to be independent and quickly find everything you need for this, we thought we would collect the most important information in this document.

However, we always remain at your disposal in case of any need!

We remind you that check out must take place by 10.00 am on the day of departure and that the keys to the House must be handed over directly to us or, if this is not possible, please leave them on the white table at the entrance, thank you.

Little house rules

- - Smoking is prohibited in the house but you can do so comfortably by sitting in the equipped outdoor area.
- - It is not allowed to organize parties.
- We kindly ask you to respect the neighborhood by avoiding making too much noise from 10.00 pm in the evening to 8.00 am in the morning.
- - Please respect the rooms and furnishings of the house as if it were your home.
- In case of loss of the keys to the house, you will pay a penalty of €uro 50.
- We, the managers, decline any responsibility in the event of loss of any object belonging to the guests staying.
- You can have additional guests as long as you pay the difference in stay but, importantly, you must communicate their personal details to us in order to fulfill the obligations of the current legislation on hospitality, to the competent local authorities.

What do you find nearby

If you need a market you have to go along via Matotta and then turning right about 400 meters onto via Partanna Mondello, you will find the Conad Superstore and a couple of hundred meters further on, you will find the Eurospin.

- If you want to go to a shopping center less than 2 kilometers away you will find the Conca D'oro.
- If you are looking for a pharmacy, you will have to go along via Matotta to the end and turning left into via Partanna Mondello, you will find it along the road about 700 meters away (about 7 minutes on foot) and in the immediate vicinity you will also find a bakery, a minimarket and the tobacconist.
- If you feel like eating fresh local fish, all you have to do is go to Piazza Partanna Mondello or to the nearby Via landolino (about one km from Via Matotta), where you will find some well-stocked fishmongers.

- If you want to travel by bus, exiting via Matotta on the right, onto via Partanna Mondello, you will find the stop about 50 meters away.
- If you want to travel by train, you will have to reach the nearest metro station about 2 km away by car or 20 minutes on foot, i.e. Tommaso Natale station.

PLACES TO VISIT

<u>Mondello</u>

The wonderful seaside village of Mondello is renowned for its beach of fine white sand and crystal clear sea and for its enchanting Art Nouveau villas. An ideal place to spend time relaxing between sun, sea and good food to be enjoyed in the many characteristic restaurants on site.

Right in the immediate vicinity, you will find the Capo Gallo nature reserve where you can take walks between the sea and uncontaminated Mediterranean nature.

To reach Mondello (2.5 km) it takes 20 minutes by bus (n.614);

35 minutes on foot; 6 minutes by car;

Sferracavallo/Barcarello

Ancient seaside village characterized by a coast with rocks, natural slides and sea crystal clear with a splendid view of the nearby Isola delle Femme.

Here you can taste typical Sicilian fish-based dishes and much more in the many restaurants overlooking the sea.

To reach Sferracavallo (4km) it takes 8 minutes by car and 23 minutes by bus.

Island of female

A small seaside town lapped by a crystal clear sea, characterized by a long varied coastline between rocks and wide beaches of fine sand.

The islet facing the coast is characteristic with an ancient history and legends to discover, which has now become a protected marine reserve and a favorite place for herring gulls.

The fish market is famous during the day and the nightlife along the entire coast. Here you can enjoy wonderful sunsets with the splendid view of the islet in the background.

To reach Isola delle Femme (6 km) it takes 10 minutes by car and 30 minutes by bus.

Addaura/ Vergine Maria

The locality is of strong historical and naturalistic interest due to the presence of the Addaura cave, one of the largest archaeological heritage sites in Sicily and a place of exceptional importance for the study of prehistoric art: it is one of the few sites that preserves engravings of Paleolithic communities in Italy.

The coast is characterized by a rocky seafront full of coves, with a sandy bottom. Traveling along the coast towards the center of Palermo we come across the beach of Vergine Maria, an enchanting place with crystal clear sea, nestled between the houses of the seaside village of the same name and dominated by the massive and evocative mass of Monte Pellegrino and closed by the building of the old and famous tuna factory Florio Bordonaro.

To reach Addaura (5 km) it takes 10 minutes by car and 30 minutes by bus, however, to get to Vergine Maria (10km), it takes 15 minutes by car and 45 minutes by bus.

Sanctuary of santa Rosalia

The Sanctuary of Santa Rosalia, patron saint of Palermo, is an important place of worship but also one of the most evocative monuments in the city, capable of moving famous writers such as the romantic poet Johann Wolfgang Goethe. You cannot remain indifferent to this church with a truly particular structure, which can be reached by car along a winding road from which you can enjoy a splendid view of the city of Palermo or on foot via a long staircase which for the Palermitans devoted to Santuzza is called "l'acchianata".

The church is built close to the cave where Santa Rosalia lived the last eight years of her life, forming one with Monte Pellegrino, the Sacred Mountain of the people of Palermo.

It is a touching and stunning sight, which strikes visitors for the strength of the religiosity it manages to emanate but also for the architectural ingenuity of its builders.

To reach the sanctuary (18km) it takes about 25 minutes by car.

Tour of the historic center of Palermo

Not to be missed:

- Quattro canti and Fountain of Shame (Piazza Pretoria)

- Arab-Norman route, a UNESCO heritage site (Cathedral, Royal Palace, Palatine Chapel, San Giovanni degli Eremiti, Martorana church, San Cataldo, Zisa, Ponte dell'Ammiraglio, Monreale Cathedral, Cefalù Cathedral)

- Teatro Massimo

- Politeama Theatre

- Botanical Garden

- Chinese Building, Pitrè Museum and many other locations of historical and cultural interest scattered around the city.

- Typical markets of Vucciria, Ballarò and Capo where you will discover the incomparable STREET FOOD of Palermo.
